



## Adanell Buffum Snider

February 3, 1917 - October 20, 2012

Adanell Sarah Buffum was born February 3, 1917, at Arcade, New York, the daughter of John O. and Mabel Eliza Mead Buffum. She died October 20, 2012 at the age of 95.

She was pre-deceased by a brother, Horatio; sister, Arcola; daughter, Sarah Ann; and daughter-in-law, Pam Eads Snider.

Adanell attended school at Pike, New York; Houghton College; Cornell University; and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in home economics from John Brown University. She taught in the Home Economics department of JBU. On May 23, 1942, she married Marion Snider. They raised four children: Sarah Ann, Nancy Jean, Stewart Randall, and Melanie Marion. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Siloam Springs, was active in PTA, Band Mothers, Koinonia Club, Rotary Anns, PEO Chapter CE, University Women's Club, and Women's Circles at First United Methodist Church.

She is survived by Marion, her husband of 70 years, children Nancy, Stewart, Melanie and husband Wayne Mason; 6 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. She is also survived by son-in-law Howard Wisdom, and long time family friend, Sondra Wattenbarger.
