Anthony Overton Gann, 74, lifetime resident of Kansas, Oklahoma, died on November 1, 2020 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was born on July 28, 1946 in Siloam Springs, Arkansas, to Overton Gann and Lela Winfield Gann. Anthony graduated from Kansas High School in 1964. He married Patsy Russell on July 23, 1966 in Lowrey, Oklahoma. Anthony owned and operated Steveson LP Gas in Kansas since 1978. He served on the Kansas School Board for many years. Anthony was a member of Kansas Volunteer Fire Department for 25 years, serving as Fire Chief for over 10 years. He was a member of Twin Oaks Baptist Church in Kansas.
