



## Arch Raymond Roller

September 4, 1919 - January 18, 2013

Arch Raymond Roller, 93, of Decatur, Arkansas, died January 18, 2013, at Washington Regional Hospital, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born September 4, 1919, in Batesville, Arkansas, he was the son of Tom F. Roller and Julia Della Ellis Roller. He was an Army veteran of World War II. He married Marjorie Close on June 25, 1939. Arch was owner and operator of the Roller General Store in Decatur until it sold in 1955. He worked for Peterson Industries for 47 years as a feed mill manager and later as a farm manager. Arch was a member of Decatur United Methodist Church, Decatur, Arkansas. He was preceded in death by his wife; one son; one brother; and one sister. Survivors include one son, Alan Roller and wife Nancy of Tontitown, Arkansas. Funeral services will be 1:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 22, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Rev.
