Arne Melvin Dahl, 82 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died June 17, 2016 at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale, Arkansas. Born June 8, 1934 in Santa Monica, California, he was the son of Roy Dahl and Solveig Schau Dahl. Arne graduated with a Master's Degree from Southern Methodist University. He was a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Air Force, where he served for 22 years. Arne was a Veteran of the Vietnam War. Arne married Alice Hunt Laeger on January 7, 2007 in Siloam Springs.
