



## Arthur Quell

June 22, 1917 - January 9, 2008

Arthur Bernard Quell, 90 year-old resident of Culpepper Place Assisted Living in Springdale, Arkansas, formerly of Siloam Springs, died January 9, 2008 at Washington Regional Medical Center. Born June 22, 1917 in Monroe, Michigan, he was the son of August Quell and Bertha Roberts Quell. He married Rose Susan Pipis at Monroe, Michigan in 1942. 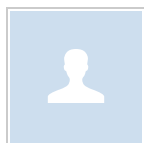
