“ I remember him... I remember him from family reunions years ago. I remember how we used to mess around with him and his sister, cause I didn't know the rest of the family.



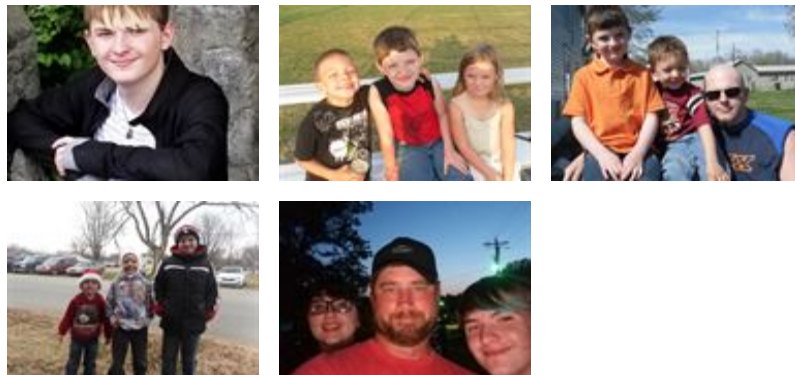
