Auzzie M. Warlick, 91 year-old resident of Proctor, Oklahoma, died November 25, 2011 at his home. Born December 14, 1919 in Lone Grove, Oklahoma, he was the son of James A. Warlick and Francis Cain Warlick. He married Thelma Miller in 1979 in Carney, Oklahoma. He served his country in WWII as a member of the Army Air Corps and retired after a long career in the Air Force Reserves. Auzzie was a member of the Kansas First Baptist Church.

Auzzie was preceded in death by his wife, four brothers, Eddie Warlick, Gene Warlick, Cain Warlick, and Walker Warlick; two sisters, Gertrude Young, and Margaret Jay.
