



## Barbara Anne McCartney

July 1, 1927 - September 12, 2014

Barbara Anne McCartney, 87 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died peacefully September 12, 2014 at Highland Healthcare and Rehab, Bella Vista. Born July 1, 1927 in Fullerton, California, she was the youngest daughter of Frank A. Treadwell and Ruby (Esmay) Treadwell. Barbara married her college love, Richard Thomas McCartney on October 1, 1947. Their long journey together took them to North Carolina, Oklahoma, Texas and Arkansas. She was a member of First Baptist Church, Siloam Springs, where she taught Sunday School and led a crafts ministry.

Barbara had a passion for people and knew no strangers, only unmet friends. She was given an extra measure of creative talent in voice, writing, painting, drawing and handcrafts. She shared these abilities to teach and delight until the very end. 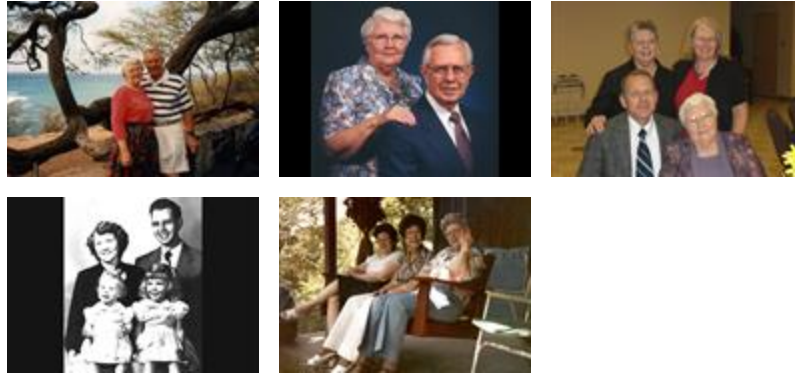
