



## Barbara Dalene Sikes

February 22, 1928 - December 7, 2012

Barbara Dalene Sikes, 84, of Gentry, Arkansas, died December 7, 2012, at her home. Born February 22, 1928, in Glasco, Kansas, she was the daughter, of Dale Marzolf and M.
