

Barhem M. Dahabreh

On April 4, 2019, the Lord called home Barhem M. Dahabreh, age 74. He was a beloved husband, father and grandfather. A resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas and previously Arvada, Colorado, he passed away at Circle of Life Hospice, Springdale, Arkansas. Barhem was born on December 10, 1944 to Musa & Ratha Dahabreh in his beloved village of Shatana-Irbid-Jordan. Barhem was one of 6 sons and 4 daughters born to his very young parents in their small Christian village in northern Jordan. He was a son, a brother, a husband and above all a father & grandfather. 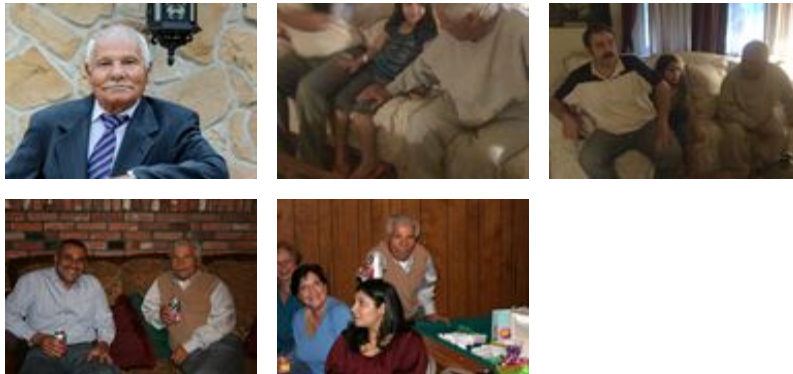
