Barney Leon “Joker” Wilkerson, 86, of Colcord, Oklahoma, died February 8, 2012, at Quail Ridge Living Center, Colcord. Born May 26, 1925, in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, he was the son of Jay Hugh Wilkerson and Christina Bishop Wilkerson. He was a lifetime resident of the Colcord area. Joker was an Army Veteran of World War II., taking part of the Normandy invasion as an infantry man. He was a farmer and raised turkeys and stock cows. He was a former member of the Union Grange and enjoyed fishing and camping. Joker was a member of Faith Baptist Church, Colcord.

He was preceded in death by his wife Ruth Marie Jackson Wilkerson; four brothers; and three sisters.
