August 16, 1931 - March 30, 2008

Bill Chandler, 76 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died March 30, 2008, at Heritage Park in Rogers, Arkansas. Born August 16, 1931, in Osgood, Indiana, he was the son of Lawrence Chandler and Marguerite Kettle Chandler. He was an Army Airborne Veteran of the Korean War.
