Billy "Bill" Earp, 77, of Colcord, Oklahoma, died July 25, 2015, at St. Francis Hospital, Tulsa, Oklahoma. Born August 9, 1937, in Colcord, Oklahoma, he was the son of Otto Samuel and Edna Serene (Sims) Earp. Bill and Phyllis Wofford were married June 6, 1964. He was life long resident of Colcord and graduated from Colcord High School in 1955 and Northeastern State University. Bill was the head basketball coach, served as principal and assistant Athletic Director, for the Colcord School District, in addition he drove a school bus for many years.

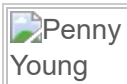
