Billy Holt, age 66, of Proctor, Oklahoma, passed away December 3, 2025, at home. 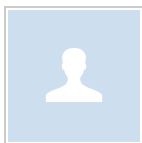

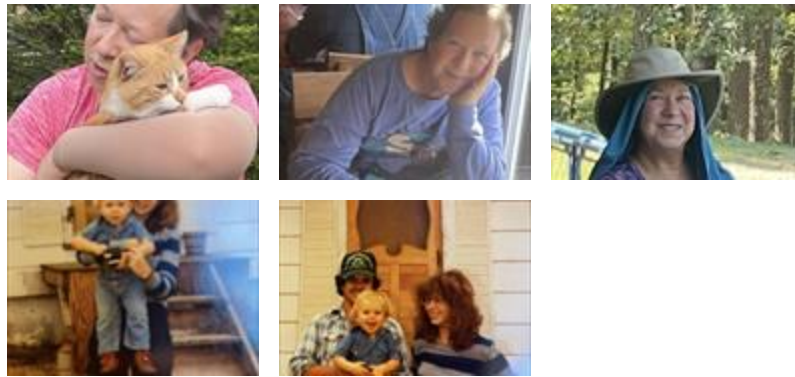
“ *Billy was a bright star here on earth. She left this world too soon, but we know she is up there shining brightly.*
