Army 1st Sgt. Blue Charles Rowe, 33, of Whittier, California, died May 26, 2009, in Afghanistan. Born May 22, 1976 in Claremore, Oklahoma, he was the son of Winston Rowe and Glenda Bledsoe Rowe.
