Bonnie Rae Thompson Newton, 90, of Gentry, Arkansas, passed away on January 11, 2025. 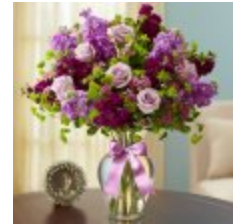
