Bradley Earl Holroyd, 60 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died September 12, 2015 at Siloam Springs Regional Hospital. Born January 14, 1955 in Waterloo, Iowa, he was the son of Dale Wilbur Holroyd and Bernice Ness Holroyd. Brad married Debra Morrison on August 7, 1976 in Oskaloosa, Iowa. He worked for 29 years as an environmental chemist with Swepco. Brad was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Siloam Springs. He was an avid sports fan and never met a stranger. 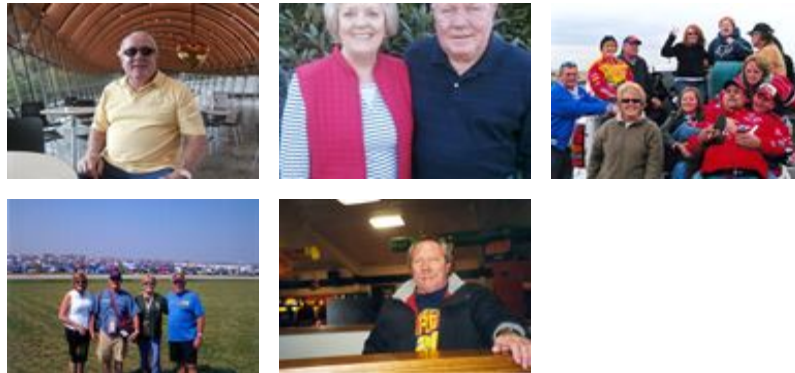

“ I was very sad to hear of the passing of Brad Holroyd. For the two years that I worked at the Harps in Siloam Springs, Brad was always one of my favorite customers to serve.
