



## Bryan Junior Morgan

January 16, 1936 - April 11, 2015

Bryan Junior Morgan, 79 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died April 11, 2015 at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born January 16, 1936 in Allen, Oklahoma, he was the son of George Andrew Morgan and Margaret Nancy Burns. Bryan married Edith Tusinger on October 30, 1955 in Riverside, California. He was a member of the Alpha Chi Honor Society while he attended John Brown University in Siloam Springs. Bryan spent many years working for Union Pacific Railroad, Bourns Aerospace, City of Siloam Springs Electric, Gates Rubber Company and Dayspring. He was a member of First Assembly of God in Siloam Springs, where he served on the Board of Deacons for many years.

Bryan enjoyed walking his dog Bella around while training for the Senior Olympics. He was a multiple gold medal winner at the Senior Olympics in Harrison, Arkansas. Bryan recently self published a collection of his own poetry. He sold the books at his church and the Siloam Springs Senior Activity Center. A portion of the proceeds from the book went to First Assembly and the Senior Activity Center.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Edith; one brother, Jerry Morgan; and one sister, Elizabeth Ramos.

He is survived by one daughter, Donna Morgan of Siloam Springs; two sons,

Alan Morgan and wife Brenda of Siloam Springs and Glen Morgan and wife Melaney of Siloam Springs; nine grandchildren; one great grandchild; one brother, Jim Morgan and wife Mary of Yucca Valley, California; and two sisters, Billie Elgin of Long Beach, California, and Pat Stern of Phoenix, Arizona.

Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m., Friday, April 17, 2015 at First Assembly of God Church, Siloam Springs, with Pastor Gary Wheat officiating. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs. Visitation will be 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Thursday, April 16, 2015 at Wasson Funeral Home, Siloam Springs.
