

Carl Eugene Baker

June 7, 1927 - December 19, 2017

Carl Eugene Baker, 90 year old resident of Wedington Community, Arkansas, died on December 19, 2017 at his home. Born on June 7, 1927 in Siloam Springs, Arkansas, he was the son of William Baker and Malinda Richey Baker. He served with the Merchant Marines during World War II. Carl married Phoebe Johnson on September 4, 1947 in Cane Hill, Arkansas. He worked as a lever operator for the Chicago Metro Transportation. Carl was a member of the Masonic Lodge, Order of the Eastern Star, and Ozark Foxtrotters Riding Club. He was a member of Wedington Baptist Church, where he was ordained as a Deacon in 1954.

He was preceded in death by one daughter, Vicki Elaine Hamilton; three brothers, Charles Baker, Dean Baker, and John Baker; and one sisters, Sue Mounce.

He is survived by his wife, Phoebe Baker of the home; two sons, Dennis Eugene Baker and wife Ladonna of Imperial, Missouri, and Carl Michael Baker and wife Rhonda of Summers, Arkansas; nine grandchildren; 16 great grandchildren; one great great grandson; and one brother, Owen D. 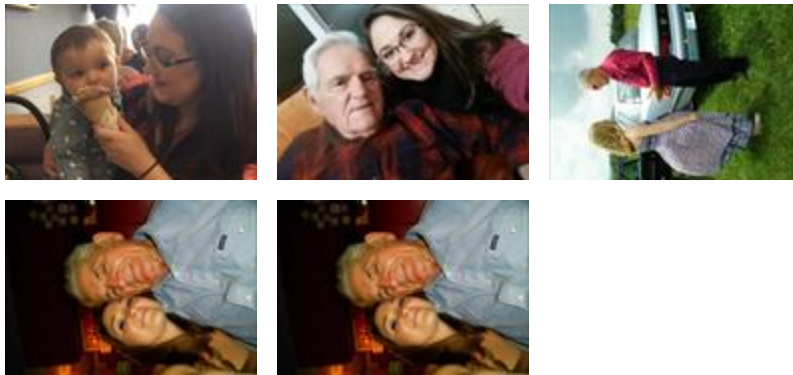
