September 7, 1919 - October 11, 2009

Carl Lynch Butler, 90, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died peacefully at home surrounded by family on October 11, 2009. Born September 7, 1919, in Gentry, Arkansas, he was the son of Ernst Watts Butler and Fannie Mae Walker Butler. He lived most of his life in the Gentry and Siloam Springs area where he sold Fords and farmed. Carl worked for Crain Motor Company in Siloam Springs, and Randall Sanders Ford in Rogers, Arkansas. Carl was a member of the Gentry Lodge #222 F&AM, and the Knights Templar. He loved sports and traveling and was a member of First Landmark Missionary Baptist Church in Springdale, Arkansas. He was preceded in death by his wife Alma in May, 2001; six sisters; and one baby brother. Survivors include two sons, Clifford Butler and wife Mariguinn of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, and Lynch Butler and wife Kathy of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; seven grandchildren; 20 great grandchildren; and 1 great great grandchild.
