Carolyn Sue Anglin, 67 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died December 9, 2005, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born January 11, 1938 in Texarkana, Arkansas, she was the daughter of Daniel Lamar Reasons and Reba Ruth Rogers Reasons. Sue was a graduate of Siloam Springs High School and was a secretary for the Public School in Siloam Springs for 25 years. She had served as a member of the City Council for the past 27 years. She was a member of the Siloam Springs Riding Club, and was active as an advisor in the Rainbow Organization. She was also a member of the First Baptist Church of Siloam Springs. Sue married Milfred Dean Anglin on August 10, 1957. Survivors include her husband Milfred of the home; her mother, Ruth Reasons of Siloam Springs; one son, Randy Anglin of Dallas, Texas; one daughter, Pennie Anglin Brewer and husband Scott of Fayetteville, Arkansas; two grandchildren, Mollie Brewer and Ian Brewer, both of Fayetteville, Arkansas. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 13, 2005, at the First Baptist Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Dr. John Terry and Mr. Louie Thomas officiating.
