I remember shooting off bottle rockets and firecrackers grilling hamburgers, swimming in spavinaw and driving grandpa Carson's chevy pickup. I remember those happy times and will always remember my grandpa Carson and my grandma Helen (Thompson) Ford with both of them laughing and happy with a smile on their faces.

Grandpa Carson and Grandma Helen divorced later as sometimes happens to families. Each went their own way for the remainder of their lives and picked up the pieces and started over. My grandpa Carson took care of his cattle farm and worked faithfully everyday at Daisy BB gun in Rogers for close to 40 years, Often times the physical strain and long hours of work would leave him so tired he would sometimes fall asleep at the wheel and run off of the road. When my great grandpa Clarence passed away He stepped up and looked after grandma Gertie for many years just to keep her from having to go to a rest home. If you have ever provided care for an elderly disabled loved one you know that it isnt an easy job.

My Dad, Carl Ford and Lois Ford, my other mother (She is deserving of a higher title than stepmom) Cared for my grandpa Carson in their home after his disabling stroke two years ago. Just as they did for my Grandma Helen in her last years. I know they both loved Jesus and will both be in heaven where there is no blame and there is no fault nor bitterness but peace, love and Joy everlasting.
