Charles Burian “Chuck” Blackburn, 75, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 15, 2012, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born December 2, 1936, in Pinsonfork, Kentucky, he was the son of Andrew Jackson Blackburn and Noleeka Meadows Blackburn. He moved to Bella Vista, Arkansas, from Minneapolis, Minnesota, in 1986, and from Rogers to Siloam Springs in 1996. He was a real estate agent. Chuck graduated from Power and Light Gospel School of Evangelism and was ordained in 2001.

He also worked as a contract painter for several years and from 2002 to 2007, he worked part-time at Wasson Funeral Home. Chuck married Mary Jane Pettie in Siloam Springs, on October 26, 1996. He was a member of the First Assembly of God Church, Siloam Springs. Chuck was an avid sports enthusiast. He ushered at University of Arkansas Razorback football games, basketball games, gymnastics, as well as track meets. He was also a high school basketball and football referee for 30 years and was a member of Arkansas Officials Association.
