Charles Wayne Pickell, 90, passed from this life on January 23, 2019. He entered this world on November 10, 1928 in Row, Oklahoma and was raised in Colcord. He was the son of James Edgar Pickell and Mary Elizabeth (Blocker) Pickell. He passed in Hollister, Missouri where he had recently moved to be closer to family.

He joined the United States Air Force in 1948 and was stationed in Anchorage, Alaska and San Antonio, Texas. He married Louise McJunkin on December 1, 1951. 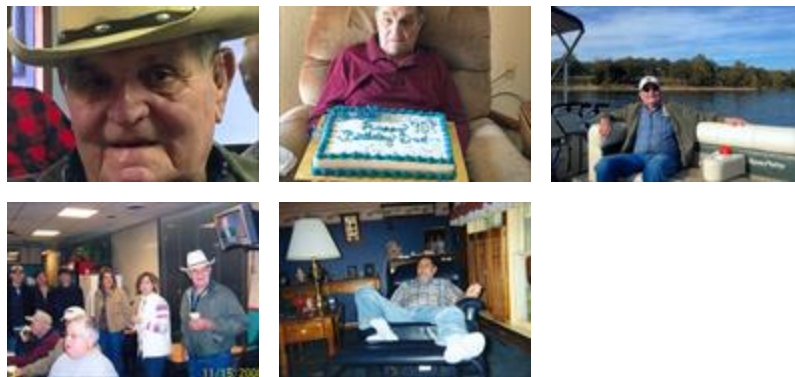
