Charles Joe White, 82, of West Siloam Springs, Oklahoma, died December 10, 2011, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born November 19, 1929 in Blackwell, Oklahoma he was the son of Manford Sigsbee White, M.D., and Anna Marie Schlaak White. He served in the Korean War as a forward observer.
