



## Charlie Cripps

February 6, 1910 - January 7, 2005

Charlie B. Cripps, 95 year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died Friday, Jan. 7, 2005 in the Siloam Springs Nursing and Rehab. Center. Born Feb. 6, 1910, in Greeley, Kansas, he was the son of Coit and Daisy Perkins Cripps. Most of his life was spent in the Gentry Area. He was a retired farmer and a member of the First Baptist Church, Gentry, where he was a deacon. He had also been a deacon at the First Baptist Church at Colcord, Okla. Mr. Cripps was preceded in death by his wife of Virda Porter Cripps and two sons, Ervin and Herman Cripps.
