



Claud "C.E." Emanuel Todd

December 16, 1937 - February 14, 2025

Claud E (CE) Todd, 87, of Siloam Springs, AR, passed from his earthly home to his heavenly home on February 14, 2025.

CE was born to the late Robert Rockford and Winnie Mabel (Guthrie) Todd. December 16, 1937, in Enid, OK. He graduated from Capitol Hill High School in Oklahoma City in 1956 and upon graduation enlisted in the Navy. Upon finishing his service in the Navy, Claud received his Bachelor's degree, a Master's Degree in Education, and post Master's certification in Educational Leadership and Administration.

Claud was a teacher and elementary principal in the Oklahoma City public school system, and an elementary school principal and assistant superintendent in the Harrah, OK public school system until taking an early retirement in 1988. In 1991, Claud began his second tenure in education in Arkansas serving both the Dover, AR, and Decatur, AR public school systems before retiring again in 2004. He then began working at Lowes Hardware store in Siloam Springs from 2006 until 2019.

Claud was an active member of Cross Church, Springdale, and served several terms on the Siloam Springs City Planning Commission.

He is preceded in death by his parents; and brothers: Donald Gene Todd and Robert Patton Todd.

Claud is survived by his wife, Sarah Ann (Little) Todd, two children from his first marriage to Carole Louise (Jackson) Todd: Kari Todd Jarrett and husband Travis Jarrett of Gravette, AR, and Rockford R. Todd and wife April Todd of
