Cleo McCollough, 88-year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Friday, December 31, 2005, at his home. Born April 13, 1916, in Rome, Arkansas, he was the son of John D. McCollough and Margaret Rebecca Allen McCollough. Cleo had lived in Siloam Springs since 1979, moving here from Kansas City, Kansas. He married Ilda Philpott in 1939 in Decatur, Arkansas. Cleo was an Army veteran of World War II, serving in the South Pacific. He was a carpenter, building bridges along with other heavy construction.
