February 6, 1930 - September 9, 2006

Clinton Eugene Jenks, 76 year-old resident of Colcord, Oklahoma, passed away, September 9, 2006 at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born February 6, 1930, in Gentry, Arkansas, he was the son of Ben and Ruby (McMorris) Jenks. He was a life-long resident of the Northeast Oklahoma and Northwest Arkansas area. He married Sue Smythe at Gentry, Arkansas on May 20, 1955. He was a veteran of the Air Force during the Korean War. He worked as a dairy farmer on his own farm.
