October 5, 1916 - January 15, 2005

Clovis Colbert, 88-year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Saturday, January 15, 2005, in Springdale, Arkansas. Born October 5, 1916, in Caddo, Oklahoma, he was the son of Richard Earl Colbert and Emma Gertrude Owens Colbert. Clovis had been in Siloam Springs since 1975, moving here from Sonoma, California, where he worked for Safeway Corporation until his retirement. He was a World War II Navy veteran, serving in the South Pacific. Clovis married Marjorie Fellis November 16, 1946, in Reno, Nevada. They enjoyed 58 years of marriage. He enjoyed raising cattle during retirement and was a member of Eastgate Church of Christ in Siloam Springs. Clovis was preceded in death by a son, David William Colbert and by his brother R.B. Bob Colbert. Survivors include his wife Marjorie Colbert of the home; 2 sisters, Dovie Mae Burris of Sun City, Arizona; Alene Wright of Denver, Colorado; and 1 granddaughter, Bridget Colbert of Craig, Colorado. A memorial service will be 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, January 18, 2005, at Wasson Memorial Chapel in Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Mr. Charles Cash officiating. Inurnment will be at a later date in Sonoma, California. Cremation arrangements are under direction of Wasson Funeral Home.
