



## Clyde McClelland

July 20, 1928 - April 27, 2006

Clyde Arnold McClelland, 77 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died April 27, 2006, at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale, Arkansas. Born July 20, 1928, in Row, Oklahoma, he was the son of Arnold McClelland and Lottie Bobo. He moved from California to the Siloam Springs area in 1975. He was a cattle farmer and a member of Eastgate Freewill Baptist Church in Siloam Springs, Arkansas. He married Sheila Ruth Amos on July 4, 1984 in Carson City, Nevada.
