Cody Scott Noble, 16, of Cincinatti, Arkansas, died November 2, 2009, at his home. Born November 13, 1992, in Fayetteville, Arkansas, he was the son of Scott Noble and Cara Waldo Noble. Cody was a junior at Siloam Springs High School and was on the High School Honor Roll. He was a member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, was a team Captain of the Siloam Springs High School football team, and was on the high school track team. Cody attended Harvard Avenue Youth Group. He was preceded in death by his great grandparents, Jasper and Else Severn.
