Cody William Pickering, 25 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died March 9, 2009 at Washington Regional Medical Center. Born August 21, 1983 in Springdale, Arkansas, he was the son of Douglas Pickering and Judy Blair Pickering. He graduated from Gentry High School in 2003. Cody married Melissa Nichols on June 8, 2002 at Colcord, Oklahoma. He was a member of the Church of Christ in Colcord, Oklahoma. Cody enjoyed riding his dirt bike, four-wheelers and crotch rockets, and tinkering on hot rods and pickups.

Cody was preceded in death by his father. Survivors include his wife, Melissa; one son, Zane Pickering of the home; one daughter, Kadee Pickering of the home; his mother, Judy Pickering of Cameron, Missouri; two sisters, Kendra Murphy of Texas, Michelle Loflin of California; and two special friends, Kenny Skaggs of Springtown, Arkansas, Darrell Norvell of Tonnece, Oklahoma.

Funeral services will be 2:00 pm, Friday, March 13, 2009 at Wasson Funeral Home, Siloam Springs, Arkansas with Mr. Larry Ellis officiating.
