Cynthia Jean Hartley McLean, 63 year old resident of Siloam Springs, died on September 21, 2020 at Willard Walker Hospice Home in Fayetteville, Arkansas. 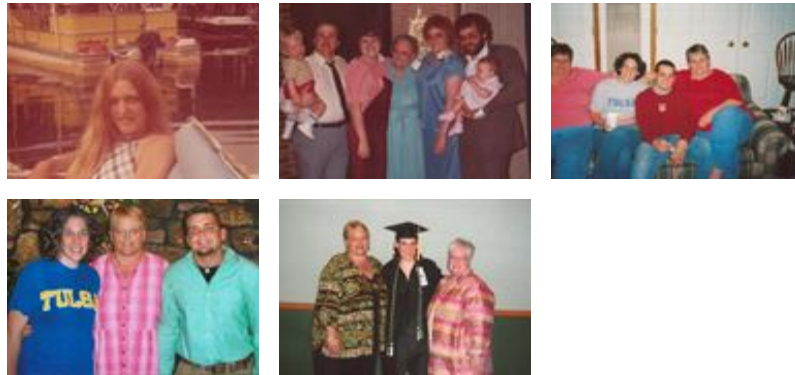
