Daniel "Danny" Richard Elrod, 64 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died on August 4, 2020 at his home. Danny was born on October 31, 1955 in Siloam Springs, to Russell C. Elrod and Doris Smith Elrod. He graduated from Siloam Springs High School and attended the University of Arkansas, where he earned his Juris Doctorate in Law. Danny practiced law for 40 years in Siloam Springs at Elrod Law Firm. He was a member of Siloam Springs Kiwanis Club for 37 years and served on the Ozark Guidance Center Board. Danny was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Siloam Springs.

He was preceded in death by his parents; sister, Imogene Wilden and brother-in-law, Bob Wilden.

He is survived by his son, Chris Elrod of Fayetteville, Arkansas; brother, John Elrod of Fayetteville, Arkansas; and niece, Adrienne Elrod of Washington, D.C.
