April 27, 1921 - August 8, 2007

David "Butch" Blackfox, 86 year-old resident of Kansas, Oklahoma, died August 8, 2007, at Regency Hospital, Springdale, Arkansas. Born April 27, 1921 in Tahlequah, Oklahoma, he was the son of Dave Blackfox and Mariah Murphy Blackfox. He was a lifetime resident of Delaware County, Oklahoma. He was a graduate of Oklahoma Tech, Okmulgee, Oklahoma with a degree in Carpentry, and of Rogers State College, Claremore, Oklahoma in Law Enforcement. He was a construction worker and bridge builder with Rollins Construction, Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was with the Cherokee Nation Security Patrol for 13 years. He was preceded in death by an infant son Bobby, one grandson Shelby; one great grandson, Reed; three sisters; one brother; and his wife Wanda Potter Blackfox in February 2007. Survivors include two sons, Jay Blackfox and wife Carolyn, and Beaver Blackfox and wife Fran, all of Kansas, Oklahoma; one daughter, Nina Turtle and husband William of Kansas, Oklahoma; eight grandchildren; 10 great grandchildren; one sister, Louise Vigil of Santa Fe, New Mexico; one brother-in-law, Johnnie Potter of Kansas, Oklahoma; one sister-in-law, Ginger Green, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma; and many nieces and nephews.
