Delbert Earl Wilkins, 94, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died August 5, 2015, at his home. Born December 10, 1920, in Decatur, Arkansas, he was the son of Syloam and Iva Leona (Burrow) Wilkins. Delbert and Wanda Gullett were married January 9, 1943. He was cabinet maker and owned and operated Wilkins Woodcraft. Delbert was also a farmer. He served his country in the Army during World War II. Delbert was a member of the Gentry Seventh-day Adventist Church.

He was preceded by his parents, his wife, two sons, five brothers and four sisters.

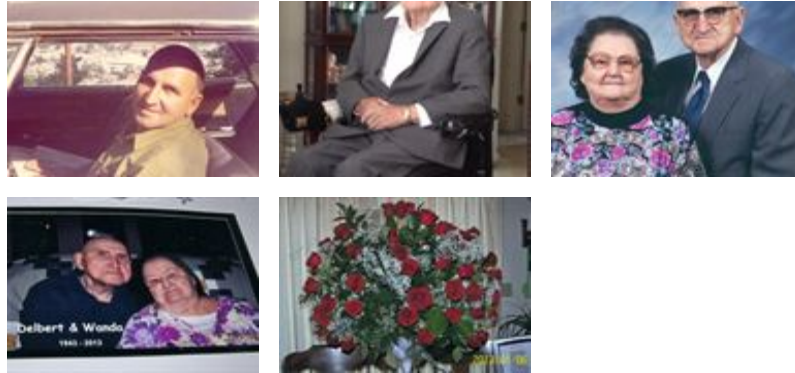
