



Dennis "Ed" Edmond Vaughan

October 17, 1931 - October 7, 2018

Dennis "Ed" Vaughan, 86 year old resident of Kansas, Oklahoma, died on October 7, 2018 at his home. He was born on October 17, 1931 in Quay County, New Mexico, to Noah Richard Vaughan and Maude Ida Jackson Vaughan. Ed moved to Kansas, Oklahoma when he was four years old and lived most of his life there. He graduated from Kansas High School. Ed served in the United States Army during the Korean War. After he returned, Ed joined American Legion Post #45 of which he was a lifetime member. He married Marilyn Bayless on May 4, 1968 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Ed worked as a builder, carpenter and electrician for many years. He spent the last 16 years over the maintenance and janitorial department at Kansas Public Schools. Ed was a member of the Kansas Church of Christ for nearly 50 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers, and three sisters.

He is survived by his wife, Marilyn; three sons, Dale Vaughan and wife Donna, of Kansas, Oklahoma, Kenneth Vaughan and wife Debbie of Turon, Kansas, and Dennis Vaughan and wife Vickie of Tonkawa, Oklahoma; daughter, Joyce Wilkerson and husband Mike of Kansas, Oklahoma; and numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.

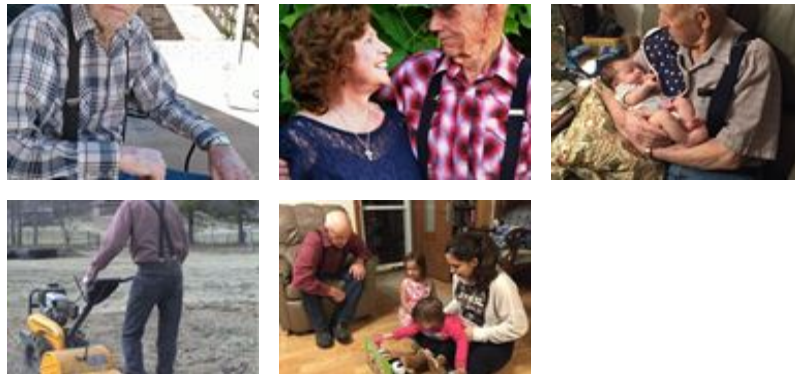
