



Don Oliver Morrow

October 8, 1935 - May 29, 2020

Don Oliver Morrow, 84 year old resident of Highfill, Arkansas, died on May 29, 2020 at his home. He was born on October 8, 1935 in Bentonville, Arkansas, to Marvin Morrow and Ithyl Lavonna Fusselman Morrow. Don graduated from Bentonville High School in 1953. He worked as a diesel mechanic by trade for many years and spent his later years as a cattle farmer. Don was a member of Alcoholics Anonymous and would have celebrated 46 years of sobriety this year.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Marvin and Ithyl Morrow; and son, John Morrow.

He is survived by five sons, Sam Morrow, James Morrow, Tom Morrow, Robert Morrow, and Steve Townzen; two daughters, Donna Powers, and Mary Morrow Guerrero; eight grandchildren, seventeen great grandchildren; and four great great grandchildren.

Graveside services will be 2:00 p.m., Thursday, June 4, 2020 at Highfill Cemetery in Highfill, Arkansas. Visitation will be from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 3, 2020 at Wasson Funeral Home in Siloam Springs, Arkansas. For the visitation, guests will be limited to 100 people at one time and everyone will be required to wear their own facemask, per the guidelines set forth by the State of Arkansas.
