June 26, 1945 - July 22, 2005

Don Corder, 60-year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died July 22, 2005 at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville, Arkansas from a motorcycle accident. Born June 26, 1945, in Sacramento, California, he was the son of Claude Corder and Violet Caterlyn Corder. Don had lived in Gentry for the past 2 years, moving there from Sacramento, California, where he had lived most of his life. Don married Judith Margaret Taylor in Reno, Nevada on February 27, 1963. He moved to Gentry to go into business with his family. Together they co-owned and operated Corder's Granite and Marble. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Ronnie Corder in 1989. Survivors include his wife, Judy of the home; 4 son's, Jim & Kary Corder of Gentry, Tim Corder of Siloam Springs, Gary & Cyndi Corder of Decatur, Arkansas and Larry & Tina Corder of Crescent City, California; 9 grandchildren; one sister, Shirley Corder of Medford, Oregon; 2 nephews and one niece.
