Donald Chester Hill, 92, of Centerton, Arkansas, died December 18, 2008, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born October 9, 1916, in Centerton, Arkansas, he was the son of George Everette Hill and Esther Duncan Hill. He was a lifelong resident of Benton County, Arkansas, and worked for Kraft Foods for 34 years and was a lifetime farmer. He married Wanda Juanita Booth in Bentonville, Arkansas in 1940.
