



## Donald Rose

November 26, 1920 - March 29, 2009

Donald Reed Rose, 88 year-old former resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died March 29, 2009, at his home in Quitman, Texas. Born November 26, 1920 in Yates Center, Kansas, he was the son of David Riley Rose and Grace Etola Bocock Rose. He lived in the Siloam Springs area since 1967, after moving from El Paso, Texas. He was a 22 and a half year retired Army Veteran. He served in World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. He was a base builder for La-z-Boy in Siloam Springs until his retirement. Mr. Rose was a member of the ERA, the DAV, the American Legion, AARP, and the Trench Rats. He married Irene Evelyn Cope in Iola, Kansas, on February 3, 1947. He was preceded in death by his wife; one daughter, Barbara S. Van Dyck and one son, Robert Leon Rose. Survivors include two daughters, Sandra Risley and husband Dave of Yantis, Texas and Beverly Ann Koenig of Louisville, Kentucky; one son, Clinton David Rose and wife Lynn of Springdale, Arkansas; numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren; and one sister, Josephine Grimes of St. Joseph, Missouri.

Graveside services will be 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, April 1, 2009, at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Brother Sam Buck officiating. Public viewing will be 1:00 to 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 31, 2009, at Wasson Funeral Home, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
