Elmer Dale McCown, 85-year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died Friday, January 28, 2005, at the Veteran's Hospital in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born April 19, 1919 in Virginia, Nebraska to George Washington McCown and Emma Pearl Hoover McCown. He married Mildred Hope Martin in Siloam Springs, Arkansas on November 17, 1945. Dale was a farmer and a retired 26-year Veteran of the United States Army serving in WWII and the Korean War. He was a lifetime member of the DAV and the American Legion in Gentry. Dale was a member of the Missionary Baptist Church of Colcord, Oklahoma. He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister Evelyn McCown; and two brothers, Chester and Donald McCown.
