



## Earl Farris

August 15, 1918 - January 13, 2008

Earl Otto Farris, 89 year-old resident of Winslow, Arkansas, died January 13, 2008 at Washington Regional Medical Center. Born August 15, 1918 in Hazard, Kentucky, he was the son of Robert Frank Farris and Mackey Sue Lewis Farris. Earl married Carma Judd on April 18, 1941, in Festus, Missouri. He was an Army Veteran of World War II and fought at the Battle of Normandy. Earl worked as a chemical worker with Mallinckrodt Chemical. He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers and four sisters.
