Edgar Allen "Tolly" Jones, 65 year-old resident of Colcord, Oklahoma, died March 12, 2006, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born January 23, 1941 in Black Fox, Oklahoma, he was the son of Lee Allen Jones and Sylvia Martin Jones. He worked for Centurytel for the past 35 years.
