



Edith Odell Schraye

January 27, 1933 - February 15, 2017

Odell Schraye, 84 year old resident of Kansas, Oklahoma, died February 15, 2017 in Burlington, Kansas. Born January 27, 1933 in Mangum, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of Arthur "Ott" Bryan and Mary (Adams) Bryan. Odell married Roy Schraye on August 30, 1948 in Clayton, New Mexico. They began their life together in Wild Horse, Colorado where they were partners with Elmer & Bertha Mayhan and George & Lucy Schraye forming the Wild Horse Land and Cattle Company. Odell and Roy then moved to Gentry, Arkansas in 1967 where they owned and operated a poultry farm until 2001. They were active in square dancing as members of the Ark-Oma Whirl-Away Square Dance Club. After retiring they relocated to Kansas, Oklahoma and spent their remaining years together there.

Odell was preceded in death by her husband in 2012, her parents, and three brothers: Henry Bryan, Garland Bryan, and Harold Dean Bryan.

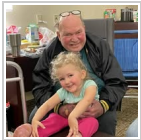
