



Edward Hessenius

September 17, 1918 - May 29, 2010

Edward Sydney Hessenius, 91 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 29, 2010 at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born September 17, 1918 in Iowa City, Iowa, he was the son of Ned Hessenius and Alice (Voogd) Hessenius. Edward graduated in 1936 from Austin High School in Austin, Minnesota. He married Margueritte "Peg" Varney on December 2, 1939 in Iowa. Edward was a Veteran of World War II serving in the Merchant Marines, then in the United States Army as a paratrooper. He moved to Siloam Springs from Mower County, Minnesota where he worked as a farmer. Edward was preceded in death by wife Peg; one daughter, Sandra Scott; and two sisters, Pauline and Gretta. Survivors include one son, Larry Hessenius of Siloam Springs; one daughter, Linda Henry and husband John of Siloam Springs; one son-in-law, Darrel Scott of Siloam Springs; six grandchildren, sixteen great grandchildren, three great great grandchildren and one brother, Richard Hessenius of Austin, Minnesota. Graveside services will be 2:00 p.m., Thursday, June 3, 2010 at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas with Dr. John Terry officiating. Burial will follow.
