Edward LeRoy Scott (CB handle Scottie Boy), 91, a resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, moved to his new residence in Heaven on February 24, 2024.

He was born on June 24, 1932, to Chester and Mildred Lee Scott in Pea Ridge, Arkansas. He was a Born-Again Believer, and a 24-year member of Westville Assembly of God. At the time of his passing, he was a ten-year member at West Siloam Springs Assembly of God.

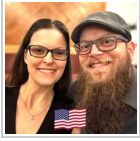
