January 10, 1930 - May 30, 2011

Elizabeth Ann “Betty” Hubbard, 81 year old lifetime resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 30, 2011, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born January 10, 1930, in Siloam Springs, she was the daughter of Clyde Davis and Cecil McCutchen Davis. She was a 1947 graduate of Siloam Springs High School. Betty was a homemaker and worked at Hunts/Stage until her retirement. Betty married Merrill Hubbard on December 23, 1948 in Siloam Springs.
