Emma Louise Cripps, 71, year old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died December 16, 2016 at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born December 18, 1944 in Stilwell, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of Woodrow Wilson English and Alta “Dewey” Louise Longbone English. She was a longtime resident of Stilwell, Oklahoma before moving to Gentry 31 years ago. Emma married Gregory Cripps on September 17, 1985. 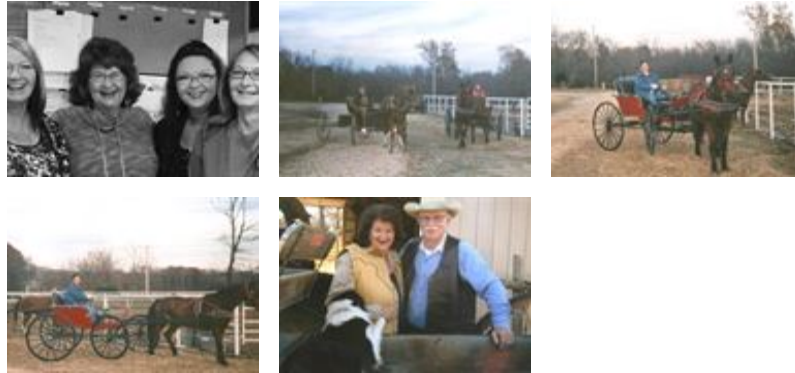
